As for community development, I am currently creating impact in the visually impaired and senior sectors through two non-profit organisations namely Etch Empathy, Cycling Without Age Singapore and a social enterprise, Fortitude Culina Pte Ltd.

Beside culinary training, we aim to augment visually impaired chefs' capability through technology thus empowering them to be a hawkerpreneur. This will allows additional career options for the visually impaired community not just in Singapore but also in Southeast Asia.
